## **Agreements, results:**

### **1. Local Workshops**

Each partner presents the results of its workshop that have been carried out at local level inside the SCS project. The Portuguese partner didn't implement yet its workshop. It will be done in April before the final meeting in Rome.

### **2. Tool kit / Products**

The format is in A5, each partner will have one page by activity and by topic (6), we could add 4 photos by page. The short description of the topic must not exceed 10 sentences. Tamás will send us the format and the script character in order to keep the same structure for everybody.

FINAL EVALUATION

#### Agreements reached:

We agreed on 2 workshops from those of partners.

#### ●**Workshop 1:** Little Prince / Dialogical literary gathering

In order to participate to the gathering people should read before the meeting the book the Little Prince and then choose a paragraph to share with persons from partners countries during the festival on Saturday. Adelaida from Spain and one or two children will conduct the workshop. More detailed instructions will be given by the Spanish partner.

#### ●**Workshop 2:** Hungarian one

Anett will implement her workshop with the help of Italian AGSDD partner. 4/6 groups will be already chosen by the Italian team to take part to this activity, but then people in the street can join the different groups if they want. More detailed instructions will be given by the Hungarian partner.

Option to be considered: a common mandala could be organized, all day long each person could contribute to the realization of the mandala.

Another Idea can be: Why not to use the mandalas method to express the views of each team for the final evaluation?

### **5. Evaluation of the meeting**

Each partner receive two post-it, one yellow and one pink. One the yellow-one Ana Rita (POR) asks to write 5 things that we disliked during this meeting and on the pink-one 5 things that we liked. Once everybody is ready, we can share with the others what we have written.

This non-formal method aims to evaluate the meeting in order to get a first impression before to receive the answers from the formal one.
